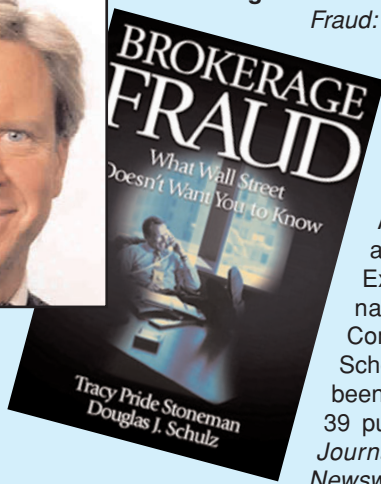
### Featured Speakers



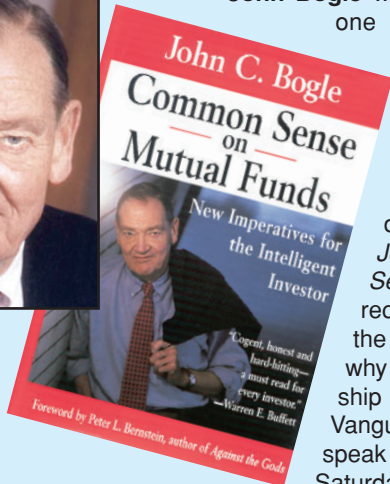
**M. Jane Brady** is the first woman to serve as Delaware's Attorney General and is our State's leading advocate for consumer protection, rights, and education. Named Delaware's Top Fraud Fighter by AARP DE, she has worked on both the national and state level to protect Delawareans from scams, abuse, exploitation and crime. She is a frequent commentator in the regional and national media, and has been featured on National Public Radio's "Talk of the Nation" and "Justice Talking" programs, CNN's "CNN Saturday" television program, the CN8 program, "It's Your Call with Lynn Doyle" and CN8's "Your Morning" program. Attorney General Brady will speak at all four investment conferences.



**Douglas J. Schulz** is co-author of the book *Brokerage Fraud: What Wall Street Doesn't Want You to Know*. With 25 years of experience, he has been consulted as an expert in approximately 1,000 cases on the rules, laws and regulations of the securities industry. An arbitrator for the NASD (National Association of Securities Dealers) and NYSE (New York Stock Exchange), Douglas Schulz is designated as a Certified Regulatory Compliance Professional by the Wharton School of Business and NASD. He has been quoted about the financial industry in 39 publications, including the *Wall Street Journal*, *Money Magazine*, *Forbes*, *Newsweek* and *Kiplinger's Personal Finance*. Douglas Schulz will speak at the Georgetown conference on March 15, 2005.



**John Bogle** was named by Fortune magazine as one of the investment industry's four giants of the 20th century. He is a titan in the investment world and a hero to independent investors. He is the founder and former chairman of The Vanguard Group, the world's largest no-load mutual fund organization. He wrote the books *John Bogle on Investing* and *Common Sense on Mutual Funds*. His most recent book, *Character Counts*, relates the story of how Vanguard was born, why it has flourished, and which leadership and management practices fostered Vanguard's development. John Bogle will speak at the Wilmington conference on Saturday, March 19, 2005.



**Michelle Singletary** is a syndicated columnist for *The Washington Post* whose popular personal finance column appears in more than 120 newspapers. She has appeared on MSNBC, CNBC, Nightline, The Oprah Winfrey Show, and The View. Understanding what it's like to live on a budget, Michelle provides answers to the financial issues that confront almost every household, such as teaching children the value of money, addressing money issues in a relationship or marriage, household saving tips, getting the best loans, and much more.
